

BYLAW NUMBER 10/01

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD TO PROVIDE FOR  
THE PARTICIPATION OF THE VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD  
FIRE/EMERGENCY RESPONSE DEPARTMENT IN MUTUAL AID.

The council of the Village of Maryfield, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts  
as follows:

1. THAT the Maryfield Fire/Emergency Service Department be authorized to leave the limits of the municipality or emergency response area, at the discretion of the Fire Chief or his/her representative, and in cooperation with the Oak Lake Mutual Aid Area Mutual Aid Coordinator, to respond to calls for assistance from other Mutual Fire/Emergency Response Departments authorized to participate in the Oak Lake Mutual Aid Area Mutual Aid System or any other Provincial Area Mutual Aid System on a no charge reciprocal basis.
2. THAT if the provisions of the By-law conflict with the provisions of any other By-law, the provision of this By-law shall prevail.
3. THAT the Village of Maryfield authorizes the Fire Chief to represent the interests of the Council in all matters affecting Mutual Aid.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of third and final reading thereof.

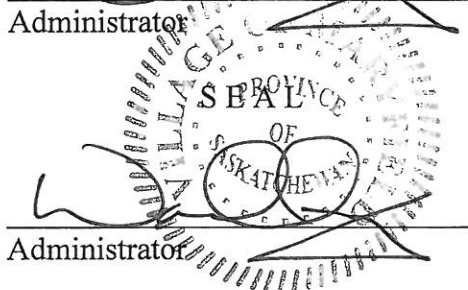
