
VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD BYLAW NO 12/08 A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES


The Council of the Village of Maryfield in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Maryfield.
2. The administrator, together with any one council member designated by council to sign cheques on its behalf, is hereby authorized to pay certain accounts either by cheques or by electronic transfer in a timely fashion, namely:
 - a) wages and salaries payable to municipal employees;
 - b) employee payroll deductions, including municipal contributions;
 - c) telephone, heat, power services;
 - d) collections on behalf of other taxing authorities;
 - e) all donations received on behalf of municipal based clubs which are to be paid in full to the club.
 - f) the water consumption invoices received from the RM of Wallace for the RO water consumed.
3. The administrator shall advise council at its next regular meeting of the particulars of transactions undertaken in accordance with section 2 of this bylaw, including but not limited to:
 - a) the transaction date;
 - b) the cheque number;
 - c) the amount paid;
 - d) the payee;
 - e) the reason for the payment.
4. Members of council are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to a public works an amount not exceeding Five Thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).
5. When a member of council authorizes a expenditure in accordance with section 4 of this bylaw, the member shall advise council at its next meeting the amount and nature of the expenditure.
