

Maryfield, Sask. May 28th 1968.

A Special Meeting of The Village of Maryfield Council was called by Overseer Haussecker for Tues May 28th at 7.30 PM in the Village Office for the purpose of dealing with an application for Sewer Extension in the Village, **Bylaw No 132 / 32** which provides for local street, driveway installations, street signposts, and the condition of the Village of Maryfield.

The Council of the Village of Maryfield in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows. Haussecker and Councillors Meadows, Cairns and Ed. Tiffen.

The meeting was called to order by the Overseer and it was moved by **(1) That the provision of the Urban Municipal Elections Act R.S.M. 1967, c. 100 respecting the preparation of the voters list do not apply to the Village of Maryfield.**

The application of the Kooosoin Co-Op Association Maryfield Branch for a Sewer Extension to the Village's present sewer system in Main Street was reviewed by Council.

(2) That the preparation of the Voters list be dispensed with and that everyone who wishes to vote be required to sign Devices Form, 21st Regina and request that this firm make a preliminary survey of the proposed sewer extension in Main Street in the Village of Maryfield. Carried.

Tiffen: That the Sec. Treas write the Dep't. of Municipal Affairs and ask the Department to supply the Village with the bylaw forms that are required to control the weight and speed of vehicles on certain Village Streets. Carried.

Meadows: That Council order at once 6 **Overseers**, 6 stop signs and 4 speed limit signs Carried.

Tiffen: That Councillor Meadows be appointed **Sec. 1 Areas** and all the Village Sports Ground Carried.

Certified a true copy of the Bylaw adopted by resolution of the Council of the Village of Maryfield on the fourth day of June, 1968. Signed as the local clerk and that the water and sewer service be supplied by the Village at no cost. Installation of fixtures etc. to be borne by the Rink Committee. Ord.

Overseer

Tiffen: That the Sec. Treas. contact the Secretary of the Hospital Board and the Sec. of the Maryfield Agriculture Association and request that a meeting from each of these boards attend at the next regular meeting of the Village Council to discuss with Council the condition of water dugouts located on their respective property in the Village. Carried.

Tiffen: That this meeting now adjourn
