

VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD

BYLAW NO. 170

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING THE STREET SHOWN ON REG'D. PLAN NO. AM 4918.

WHEREAS notice was given by publication thereof in the Moosomin World-Spectator, a weekly newspaper published in the Town of Moosomin, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the issues of January 17th, 1989 and January 24th, 1989 of the intention of the Council of the Village of Maryfield to close the street shown on Reg'd. Plan No. AM 4918.

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation of the Province of Saskatchewan has consented to the said closing;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 147 of the Urban Municipality Act have been fully complied with and no person has claimed that his land will be injuriously affected thereby, nor petitioned the Council to be hear in connection with this Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of Maryfield duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That portion of public highway in the Village of Maryfield described as follows;

All that portion of Longworth Street lying between the production westerly of the southerly limit of the most northerly 45.720 metres of Lot 16 in Block 12 as shown on a plan of record for the Regina Land Registration District as No. AM 4918 be redesignated as a Parcel.

THIS BYLAW shall come into force and have effect from and after the final passing thereof.
