

## VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD BYLAW NO 1703

### A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES.

The Council of the Village of Maryfield in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:

- a. "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Maryfield;
- b. "Service Provider" shall mean a municipality, co-operative, board or other entity who has been engaged by the Municipality to provide the fire prevention, suppression or other emergency response service.

2. Fire suppression and/or prevention services shall be delivered by the Municipality.

3. Fees relative to the service(s) identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be established as follows and may be amended by the Municipality by resolution as required.

The said fees shall be:

First Hour -- \$1250.00.

Additional Hours or part thereof -- \$800.00 per hour.

Minimum Call Out Charge -- \$500.00.

Plus consumables and damages to equipment.

4. The municipality shall charge the cost of the fire prevention and suppression services directly to the person or persons who receive the service.

5. If all, or a portion of, the charge noted in Section 4 of this bylaw remain unpaid at the end of the calendar year, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.


6. Bylaw No 02/07 is hereby repealed.
